


ORDER



4. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following: -
- (a) The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength as per NCTE norms applicable to respective course/s approved.
 - (b) The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
 - (c) The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.
 - (d) That the Reserve Fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions.
 - (e) Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government / SCERT etc.
 - (f) The institutions shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 - (g) The institutions shall regularly update their website.
 - (h) The institutions intending to run the teacher training programme approved above in a rented premises are required to shift to their permanent building. They are required to submit report in compliance of the requirement of NCTE Regulations on the subject.
 - (i) **The institution at S.No. 03 & 04 shall get the list of staff members ratified by the concerned University and send a copy to NRC, NCTE office, Jaipur.**
 - (j) Attention of the institutions concerned is also drawn to Section 12 of NCTE Regulation dt. 27.12.2005 which reads as "**The institution concerned, after appointing the requisite faculty / staff, shall put the information on its official website and also formally inform the Regional Committee concerned. The Regional committee concerned shall then issue a formal unconditional recognition order.**"

- (iii) The institution shall comply with the condition as laid down in the clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which provided that "An institution which has been recognized by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by Council within five year of such recognition."
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) The Norms of staff/ qualifications/administrative and professional staff/terms and conditions of service etc. shall be as per the provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

5. **Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution:-**

- (i) The affiliating bodies/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.
- (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is composite institution as per the definition of composite institution given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution as not a composite institution, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, in the existing institutions permitted for additional intake, shall have to ensure that they are to become composite gradually preferably the academic session 2016-17.

- (iii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
